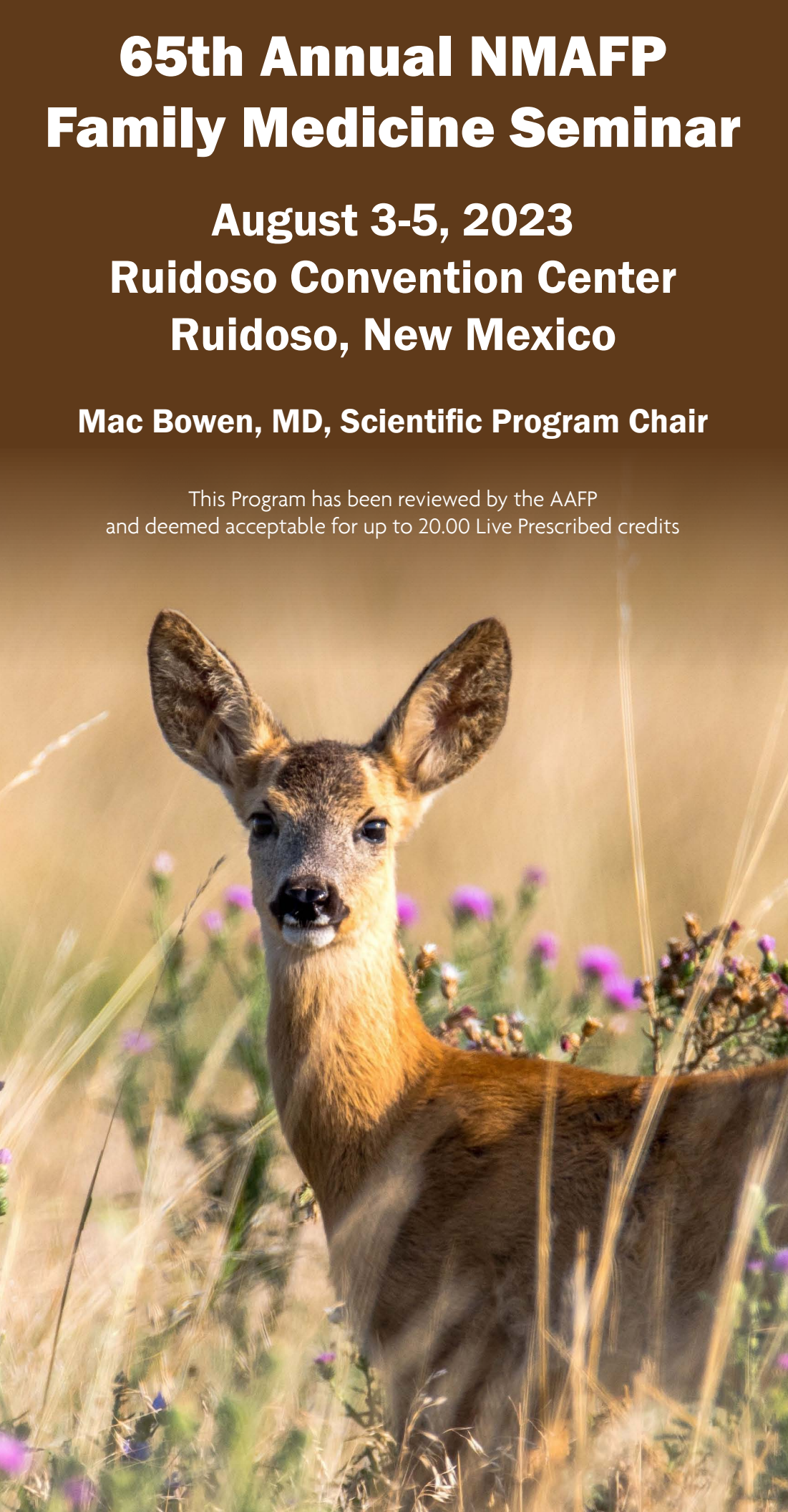


## VISITING RUIDOSO, NEW MEXICO AND THE SURROUNDING AREA
